

8. SYDNEY ROWING CLUB POLICIES

8.1 Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy

The Sydney Rowing Club is committed to the principles of Responsible Service of Alcohol.

To ensure that The Sydney Rowing Club adheres to RSA legislation we have adopted a Traffic Light System that enables all staff to effectively identify and communicate issues pertaining to RSA.

The Sydney Rowing Club prohibits any person under the age of 18 entering any area defined as a bar under the Registered Clubs Act 1976 or being served alcohol in another area.

The Sydney Rowing Club aims to provide alcohol service in a safe and responsible manner for the benefit of patrons, the community, staff and the Club.

The Sydney Rowing Club complies with regulation by ensuring alcohol is not supplied to any person who is:

- Intoxicated
- Disorderly or quarrelsome
- Under the age of 18 years

The Sydney Rowing Club will not allow any person who is intoxicated to enter the premises.

The Sydney Rowing Club supports Responsible Service of Alcohol training and ensures all staff and management attend the relevant training programs.

The Sydney Rowing Club is committed to patron care and safety by providing non-alcoholic drinks, low alcohol drinks, food available at all times and advice and assistance for safe travel via free taxi phones.

The Sydney Rowing Club aims to ensure patron activity does not adversely affect the neighbourhood.

The Sydney Rowing Club complies with the Liquor Industry's Code of Practice for the responsible promotion of liquor products by ensuring it does not present advertising or promotions which:

- Encourage excessive drinking
- Encourage irresponsible drinking habits
- Encourage rapid drinking
- Provide free drinks
- Unfairly target men or women.

Any person who feels they may have a problem related to alcohol may contact Management of the Sydney Rowing Club who will assist in seeking professional help.
